## NOTICE FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

### Conditions for Award of Scholarship

1. The student must maintain regular attendance at school
2. The student should display excellent conduct and deportment
3. The student should have excellent leadership and or be involved in service activities
4. The student must maintain at least an overall average of 60% in 5 subjects
5. The student should demonstrate significant sporting potential and be involved in sporting activities in the school
6. The student should submit verified copies of the most recent school report/ certificates along with the application or within 1 month of the application submission. Failure to do so will result in your application being incomplete.
7. The foundation must be advised of any changes in your address.
8. The awardees shall not simultaneously hold a similar Scholarship
9. The Scholarship is subjected to an annual review of your overall performance in academic achievement, grades, sports and participation in social / community activities
10. Funds will be disbursed to the applicant (monthly/annually)
11. The foundation has the right to request information directly from the school.
12. The awardee acknowledges that the Foundation can use their image, photographs and video at no cost to the Foundation
13. The awardee will be expected to provide a written testimonial or engage in public speeches as an awardee
14. This scholarship is not open to members of the board or their family members.
15. Application for Scholarship must be submit by July 31<sup>st</sup> to the office of the foundation located at 28 Barbados Avenue, Kingston 5.
16. Any misinformation, inaccuracy, misbehaviour, truancy, failing grades will lead to the disqualification of the Scholarship
